year at each of the villages of Antler and
Wauchope at the call of ratepayers

That rate of taxation for 1910, be 6 1/4 cts. per acre and that resident ratepayers be paid \$5 per day for man and team.

That bill of expenses for elections in July and December be paid.

That D. W. Hidlebaugh be Deputy Reeve for 3 months.

Motion of W. R. Campsall

That each councillor be credited with the amount of taxes collected except expenses necessary.

That the Secretary have 7 minutes of each council meeting published in Redvers Observer.

Motion of W. R. Campsall

That Reeve, Harber and Councillor Fry be a committee to wait on Bank Manager & see about cashing of cheques at par &c.

Resolved That next meeting of Council be held on Saturday Feb. 12, 1910. in Schoolhouse at Redvers.

Resolved That matter of Books and Supplies forwarded by Leader Pub. Co. Regina be left to the Sec'y with approval of Reeve.

Discussion of Wolf bounty laid over until next meeting.

That stones put in sloughs be paid for at the rate of 25 cents per cu. yard.

Resolved That J. H. Try be appointed to meet The Village Council re-matter of acquiring cemetery.
