CIVIC ADDRESS REGISTRY

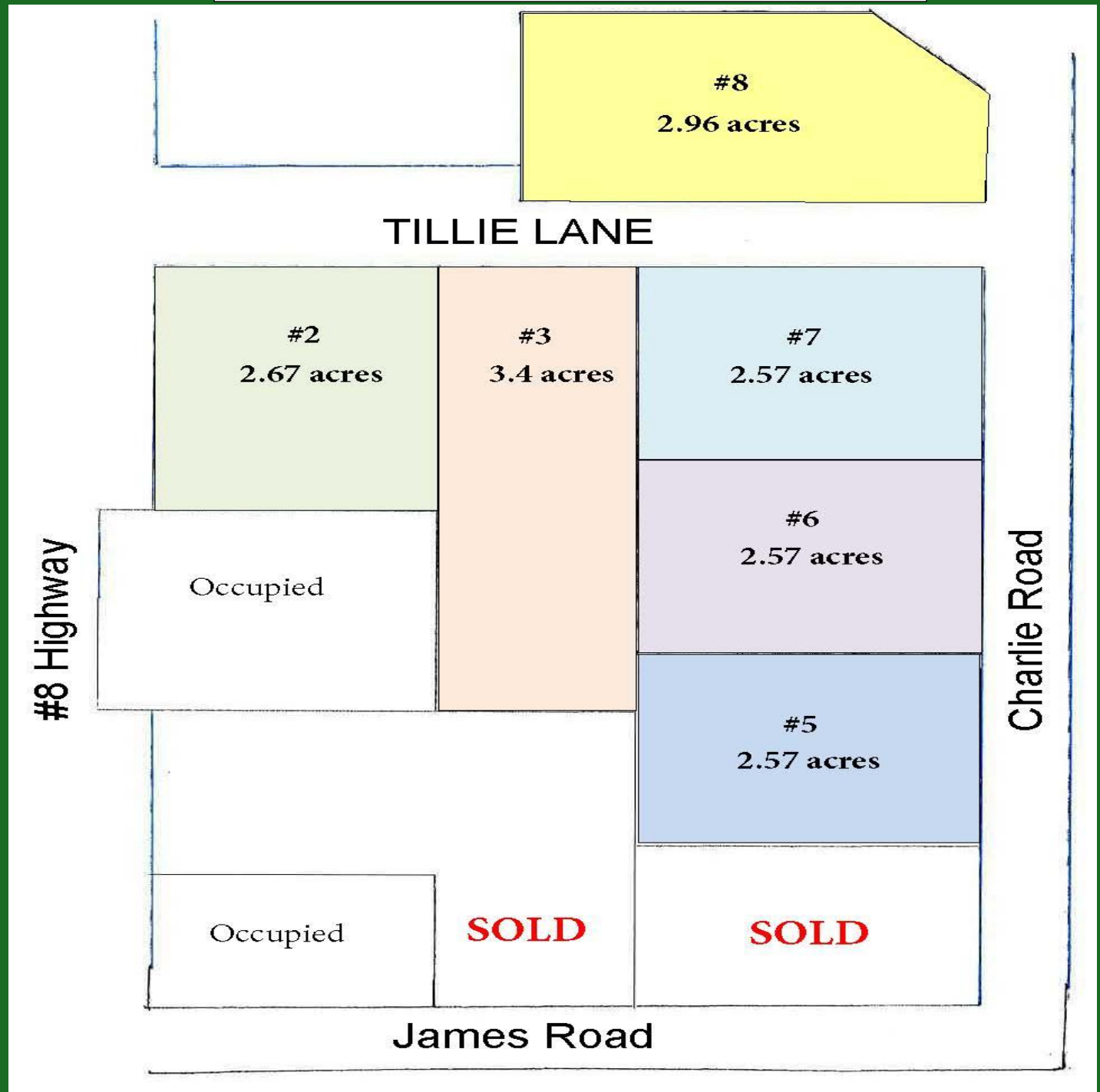
Civic Address Registry is a province-wide standardized system used to identify and locate properties by establishing unique access point locations. It assists emergency responders in quickly finding homes and businesses during emergencies.

The R.M. of Antler is in the beginning stages of this process and will be working on getting every residence within the R.M. of Antler their own unique address. This is a lengthy process that can take two years or more to complete.

Business Tax Incentive – Bylaw 9-2016

The R.M. of Antler provides the following tax incentives for **newly constructed** businesses wishing to operate within the municipality:

- Year 1: Full Municipal property tax exemption for land and improvements.
- Year 2: Full Municipal property tax exemption for land and improvements.
- Year 3: Business shall pay 33% of the Municipal tax levy.
- Year 4: Business shall pay 66% of the Municipal tax levy.
- Year 5: Business shall pay 100% of Municipal the tax levy.

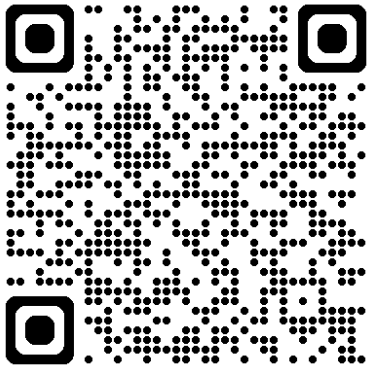
HAVE YOU SIGNED UP FOR H2NOTIFY?

The Rural Municipality of Antler has implemented H2Notify which is an Emergency Notification System.

If you were on a Road Ban email list, receive dust control, obtain Municipal Hail (SMHI), have a water key, live within the R.M. of Antler or in the Special Service Area known as Antler you **MUST** sign up as we will no longer be sending the important information by any other method.

With the new notification system, you will be able to receive the important information by email, text message or even an automated phone call if you wish.

How to use the QR Code:

On your cellular device go to the camera as though you're taking a picture, point the camera to the QR code, a small yellow pop up that says "**core.windows...**" should appear (you may have to move your camera closer or further away from the QR code image for the pop up to appear), press the yellow pop up and it will redirect you to the registration page for H2Notify. Enter the required information and press **register**! You will now receive important updates from the R.M. of Antler #61.

- Confirmation of enrollment to a post secondary agricultural related course.

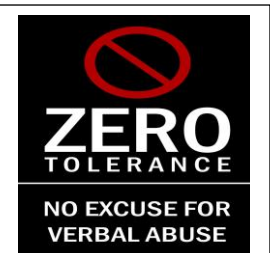

PUBLIC CONDUCT BYLAW

The purpose of this Bylaw for the Rural Municipality of Antler No. 61 is to establish a safe and welcoming environment for all individuals, including ratepayers and visitors. The Bylaw aims to allow for the expression of disappointment, frustrations, or anger towards municipal services while maintaining professionalism and respect towards the R.M. Staff and Council. It also aims to implement procedures to restrict access to municipal spaces or services for individuals or groups exhibiting unacceptable behavior. The Rural Municipality of Antler No. 61 is committed to providing a safe, respectful community where individuals of all ages can enjoy various activities and services. This Bylaw is guided by the principles of rejecting violent, abusive, harassing, threatening, disrespectful, or hostile behavior, and providing a safe, positive, and respectful environment for volunteers, staff, and all users and guests.

Abuse towards Council or staff will not be tolerated.





REDVERS FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Redvers Fire Department is working hard to meet the new required standards set out by Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency. The frontline fire truck needs to be less than 20 years old, but the newest one the Fire Department has is a 2005 model. The Fire Department is busy fundraising for a new fire truck and is also asking for sponsorships. If you would like to donate or sponsor the new fire truck you can go to the Town of Redvers Office or scan this QR code and donate online. The sponsorship levels are as follows:

Platinum: \$20,000.00 and above; Gold: \$5,000.00 to \$19,999.00; Silver: 1,000.00 to \$4,999.00 and Bronze: \$100.00 to \$999.00. The Town of Redvers is offering charitable receipts for the donations on \$25.00 and more as well as all sponsorships that are received.



The R.M of Antler applied for and was awarded a grant for two solar powered emergency flashing beacon signs for the Redvers Fire Department. These signs will be installed on Highway 8 North and South of the road going into the Fire Department. These lights will alert drivers that emergency vehicles are approaching the highway and everyone is required to allow the Fire Trucks the right of way. These lights will only be activated during a fire. Hopefully with these lights, we can safely get the Redvers Fire Department out to location quickly while keeping everyone else safe as well. Installation of these lights will take place this year.



Are You Planning a Controlled Fire?

Call **1-866-404-4911** with your location and plans to avoid firefighters from getting dispatched when it is not necessary. Invoices for the Fire Department will still be issued if they are dispatched even if the services are not required. Anyone who spots a fire can call in a fire. We also ask that you please use extreme caution when deciding to do a controlled burn. A fire can become uncontrolled quickly and if a fire gets into the ditch, the RM's poly culverts could catch on fire. The fire will burn right through the road and spread to your neighbor's field. You are liable if a fire becomes uncontrolled and causes damage to other property.

A **DEVELOPMENT PERMIT** is required when building on your property. This includes adding additions, garages, etc. This also applies to farm buildings such as shops, sheds or detached garages. A farm building is exempt from Building Inspections, but it does allow Council the opportunity to ensure you are building according to our bylaws with proper setbacks from road allowances. No permits are required if you are planning new siding, shingles or windows. Permits must go through a regular meeting of council for approval. So be sure to get them in so your building plans are not delayed!



A **BUILDING PERMIT** is required when building a new home or renovating a pre-existing home on your property. **ALL Commercial property construction requires a Building Permit.** All codes are set by the National Building Code, National Energy Code for Buildings, National Plumbing Code, and The Construction Codes Act. Municode has been hired as building inspectors for the Municipality. All the required forms for the application process can be found at the RM Office. Stop in the office and we would be happy to answer your questions!



Beaver Bounty

The R.M. of Antler Council passed a resolution to increase the amount paid for the beaver bounty. If you have a valid trapper license you can collect \$50.00 per beaver tail trapped within the R.M. of Antler #61.

What you need to do:

1. Obtain a valid Trappers License and submit it to the R.M. Office.
2. Complete the Trapper Verification Form with the dates, locations and number of beavers trapped. (Form available at the R.M. Office)
3. Take beaver tails to the R.M. Foreman for verification.
4. Submit Trapper Verification Form to R.M. Office for payment.

The R.M. appreciates your help controlling these pests, so our culverts stay clear of debris allowing the water to flow freely throughout the Municipality.

GENERAL ELECTION BYLAW 2-2025

This recent bylaw was passed March 18, 2025. It states Public Notice will be posted in the R.M. office, in a Public location within the Municipality, on the R.M. Facebook page and in a newspaper should an election ever be required. **Nomination forms shall include the nominees occupation which will also be included on the ballot, a public disclosure statement as well as a Criminal Record Check.** The Polling Place will be located at the R.M. Office at #14 Larsen Road unless otherwise specified by Council with a motion. In the event of a tie vote, 2 pieces of paper of equal size with each candidate's name will be place in a container and one person will draw a name out of the hat.

The next R.M. Election will be in the fall of 2026 for division 2, 4 and 6.

Noxious Weeds

If you see these weeds in the R.M. Road Allowance / R.M. ditch, **do not touch it**. Instead, please contact the R.M. office at (306)452-3263 with a land location or description where it is located.

These are nauxious weeds and must be controlled.



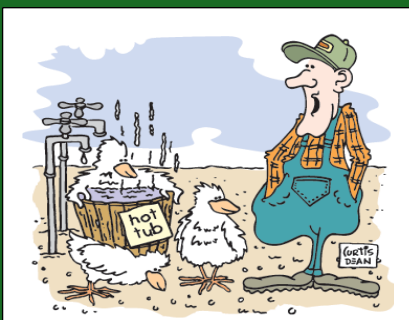

Wild Parsnip



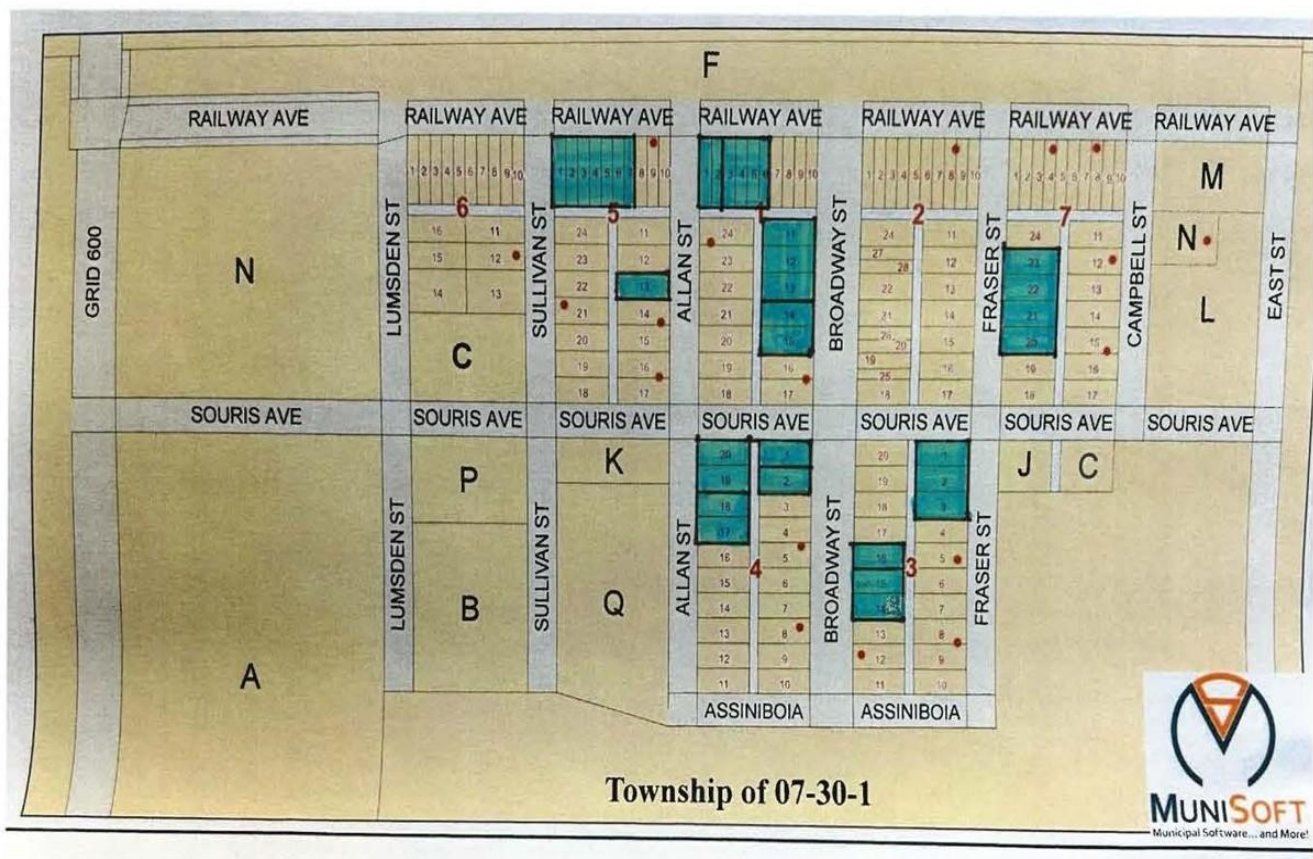
